Description

The slender baluster shaft centred by a two piece pineapple urn surmounted by a van dyke drop hung canopy, cascading to the lower spires. The chandelier terminates with a raised diamond and gadroon cut pineapple. The double ogee container issuing twelve upper kick-arms with van dyke canopies and triangular spires; these alternated with a further twelve notched cut candle arms, supporting van dyke drip pans and candle nozzles. The lower stem with draped canopy and lapidary cut final, the chandelier profusely draped with half back pear shaped drops and round finials.
